

Updated isolation and quarantine guidelines for Durant Public Schools, per new CDC and Oklahoma Department of Health guidelines are as follows:

## **Positive Cases**

Isolation for 5 days from onset of symptoms or positive test date (whichever is earliest), can return to school on day 6 if you have no symptoms, including using no fever reducing medication. The CDC and Oklahoma Department of Health strongly recommend that you wear a mask for an additional 5 days.

## **School Exposures**

Students and staff identified as a close contact to a positive case while at school will need to quarantine for 5 days from the date of exposure and can return on day 6 as long as you have not symptoms. The CDC and Oklahoma Department of Health strongly recommend that you wear a mask for an additional 5 days.

## **Household Exposures**

Students and staff that are exposed to a member of their household will be required to quarantine 5 days from last exposure to the positive case. The CDC and Oklahoma Department of Health strongly recommend that you wear a mask for an additional 5 days.

## **Vaccination Note**

Fully vaccinated students and staff members may not be required to quarantine due an exposure. The school nurse will make this determination at the time of exposure.
