<p><b>Arrival/Breakfast</b> Doors open at 7:30 Breakfast: Times will vary to accommodate social distancing, but each class will have 25 minutes for breakfast.</p>	<p><i>Counselor, Principal, and Secretary will control and monitor student arrival. Teacher Assistants will deliver breakfast to the classrooms, assist with breakfast in the cafeteria, and assist students getting safely to the classrooms.</i></p> <p>The health and safety of students and staff is our top priority. Limiting visitors in our building will be one more safeguard. Parents will remain in designated areas. We ask that you drop your child off in the mornings on the south side of the school. School personnel will be there to assist getting your children in the building.</p>
<p><b>Dismissal</b> Buses at 2:10 Car Riders at 2:30</p>	<p><i>Bus Riders – Counselor and Principal will put students on buses while maintaining social distancing.</i></p> <p><i>Car Riders – The Counselor with assistance of staff will manage car riders on the north side of the school. The Principal with assistance of staff will manage car riders on the south side of the school. Parents will be given colored coded tags to place on their rearview mirrors to assist with afternoon pickup.</i></p>
<p><b>Classrooms</b></p>	<p><i>*Student tables will be arranged in a manner that will accommodate and support social distancing.</i></p> <p><i>*Teachers will teach and model to students concerning hygiene and social distancing.</i></p> <p><i>*We will continue to prioritize and monitor academic standards.</i></p>

	<p><i>*We will continue to follow the Pre-K pacing guide.</i></p> <p><i>*Student supplies will be placed in school boxes with student names on the them.</i></p> <p><i>*Manipulatives will be sanitized on a regular basis.</i></p> <p><i>*Lion Lane and Cub Court will be sanitized on a regular basis.</i></p> <p><i>*Cleaning supplies will be available for staff.</i></p> <p><i>* In order to provide a safe learning environment, all school water fountains will be used for a water bottle filling station. Students are encouraged to bring water bottles from home, but water bottles must be CLEAR.</i></p>
<p><b>Lunch</b>  <b>Times will vary to accommodate social distancing, but each class will have 30 minutes for lunch.</b></p>	<p><i>Lunches will be provided in the classroom and in the cafeteria to provide social distancing. Teacher Assistants will deliver lunches to the classrooms and assist teachers with lunches in the cafeteria and classrooms. Lunches in the cafeteria will be staggered in order to maintain social distancing.</i></p> <p><i>Students can eat lunches provided by the cafeteria or bring a lunch to school with them in the mornings.</i></p> <p><i>To help minimize the amount of people who will be in the front office area, we will not accept lunch deliveries during the school day. If an extenuating circumstance warrants the delivery of an item to a student, parents must call the front office to make a request. Requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis.</i></p>
<p><b>Recess</b></p>	<p><i>*Recess will be staggered with only one class at a time, on each of the playgrounds, Lion Lane and Cub Court.</i></p> <p><i>*Teachers will be provided a schedule with their allotted times.</i></p>

<b>Masks</b>	<p><i>Allowed but not required.</i></p> <p><i>If the city, state or Department of Education mandates the wearing of masks, the district will adhere to those guidelines.</i></p> <p><i>As you may be aware, Senate Bill 658 (effective July 1), prohibits school mask mandates unless there is a declared state of emergency by the governor. Oklahoma, at this time, is not under a state of emergency. However, we are closely watching COVID – 19 data and are particularly concerned about the Delta variant that is continuing to spread throughout our state. We <b>STRONGLY ENCOURAGE</b> students, teachers, and staff to wear masks at school.</i></p>
<b>Field trips and School Assemblies</b> <b>Any large gathering of students, staff, or community members</b>	<p><i>Cancelled until further notice.</i></p>
<b>Electives/Specials</b>	<p><i>Special Services will continue as normal while maintaining social distancing.</i></p>
<b>Visitors</b>	<p><i>Parents will not be escorting students into the building. Essential visitors only are allowed inside. These are persons who are considered essential to the running of the school.</i></p>
